

Companion animals (**dogs cats and ferrets**) moved purposes non - commercial

must meet the following requirements:

1 They must be identified by:

- microchip, consistent with the requirements of ISO Standard 11784 or Annex A to ISO 11785 (where the microchip does not meet requirements of any of the above. standards, the owner of the animal or person that is responsible on behalf of the owner must provide the means read the microchip number during the inspection, ie must have a reader), or
- legible tattoo (if the tattoo was made before July 3 2011).

2 They must be vaccinated against rabies (Subject the importance of vaccination achieved after 21 days of its achievements in For the first vaccination on the age of the animal over 3 m-ca life (Commission Decision No 2005/91/EC of 2 February , 2005. *establishing the period after the vaccination rabies is considered to be important*). For subsequent vaccination carried regularly in intervals recommended by the manufacturer of the vaccine (booster) vaccination is achieved on the validity of a booster dose of vaccine. If the owner or person responsible for the animal does not have a certificate of making the last vaccination the animal in accordance recommended by the manufacturer of the vaccine, another vaccination is properly regarded as the first vaccination and acquires validity after 21 days from the date of filing).

3 Must be accompanied by a passport issued by an authorized veterinarian, attesting to the importance of vaccination against rabies.

For other companion animals - rabbits, hamsters, guinea pigs, mice, rats, etc. - does not require any documentation.

In the case of protected animal species covered by the Convention Washington (CITES), should be accompanied by the relevant documents.
